



HEALTH & SAFETY PAEDIATRIC FIRST AID (2 DAY)

DESIGNED TO: The Paediatric First Aid course is designed to train individuals to provide immediate First Aid care for infants and children. This course also includes adult essential skills in basic life support as they differ from the skills of the infant and child.

OBJECTIVES: This 2-Day, 12-hour accredited course meets the First Aid requirements of OFSTED for the Early Years Foundation Stage standards, the National Childminding Association, the Pre-School Learning Alliance and the Department for Children, Schools and Families Surestart guidelines for Paediatric First Aid. The course will provide First Aid skills necessary to manage an infant or child that is not breathing normally, is unconscious, bleeding or is ill or injured prior to the arrival of the emergency services.
